Recommendation for Sah Dan / Sah Dan Master Candidacy

Region 8 - WTSDA

The following are minimum requirements for Sah Dan or Sah Dan master candidacy. Instructors must verify that the potential candidate meets these requirements and submit his or her recommendation explaining why the individual should be considered. Sah Dan candidates must be a Sam Dan for 4 years* before consideration and have outstanding participation, dedication, as well as technical and leadership ability.

Sah Dan master candidates must have their own dojang with at least 25 active students, or be a chief instructor at a dojang with 100 active students or more.

The Regional Director must receive this form no later than June 1st for candidates to be <u>considered</u> for the upcoming Masters' Clinic.
